Japanese Government Scholarship for 2016

The Embassy of Japan in Timor-Leste welcomes the applications from nationals of Timor-Leste who wish to study as the Research Students in Japan. The deadline of submitting applications to the Embassy of Japan in Dili is June 5, 2015. Please see below for the details of the program!

Research Students

- Applicants generally must have been born on or after April 2, 1981.
- Applicants must have completed a 16-year school curriculum and obtained a bachelor's degree.
- This program provides an opportunity to study at Japanese graduate school and the duration of the scholarship is usually two years (if grantee passes the exam and enrolls in a master's or doctoral courses after arriving in Japan, the scholarship covers the necessary period to complete the course)
- Application procedures

Each applicant must submit three sets of the following documents to the Embassy of Japan in Dili by the specified date. One set is required to be original documents. The other two may be photocopies thereof.
