On 14 February, Associacao Haburas Capasidade Atoni Enclave (AHCAE) held an inauguration ceremony of "The Project for Renovation of Primary School in Nitibe Sub-district, Oecussi District" in Lelaufe Village, Nitibe Sub-district, Oecussi District, supported by the Government of Japan. The Government of Japan provided US\$103,050 for this project under the Grant Assistance for Grass-roots Human Security Projects (GGP).

Before implementing this project, primary school students in Lelaufe Village had to study in the school building which was built during the Indonesian occupation time with scarce school equipment such as desks and chairs. Now, with the completion of the project, the students can learn in a safe and sound school building with new equipment.
