

Japan's Assistance to Timor-Leste

Inauguration ceremony of *“The Project for the Installation of Water System in Pairara Village, Lautem Sub-district, Lautem District”*

The Government of Japan jointly held an inauguration ceremony of *“The Project for the Installation of Water System in Pairara Village, Lautem Sub-district, Lautem District”* with Masino Foundation, a national NGO, in Pairara Village, Lautem Sub-district, Lautem District. The Government of Japan provided US\$95,304 for this project under the Grant Assistance for Grass-roots Human Security Projects (GGP) Scheme.

At the inauguration ceremony, Ambassador of Japan to Timor-Leste, H.E. Mr. Fernando Lasama de Araujo, Vice-Prime Minister, H.E. Mr. Elias Moniz, Secretary of State for Water, Sanitation and Urban Development and other distinguished guests celebrated the completion of this project.

Through this project, Masino Foundation constructed a 1.7km water supply pipeline and its water supply system to the community. It is expected that this water supply system will provide safe and clean water and contribute to the improvement of the livelihood for 974 people in Pairara Village.
