Since 2000, the Government of Japan has implemented 76 projects in all 13 districts of Timor-Leste, providing water supply systems, irrigation channels, constructing and rehabilitating school buildings and other important infrastructures for the local communities. The Government of Japan implemented 16 projects for primary and secondary education. Adding new 2 projects marks 18th project under the GGP project.
