### Exchange of Notes (E/N) Signing Ceremony for the “Project for Construction of Upriver Comoro Bridge (Detailed Design)”

Friday, April 4, 2014

Today, The Governments of Japan and the Democratic Republic of Timor-Leste, represented by H.E. Mr. Yoshitaka Hanada, Ambassador of Japan to Timor-Leste, and H.E. Mr. Constâncio da Conceição Pinto, Acting Minister for Foreign Affairs and Cooperation, signed an Exchange of Notes (E/N) for the “Project for Construction of Upriver Comoro Bridge (Detailed Design)” at the signing ceremony held at the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Cooperation in Dili.

The Government of Japan had decided a grant up to eighty-six million (86,000,000) Japanese Yen to implementing the project. The final objectives of this project are to construct a new bridge across the Comoro River to distribute the traffic within the city and mitigate the congestion.

By signing the E/N today, the Government of Japan provides reliable detailed design to construct new bridge. At the completion of the project, the new bridge will be able to hold heavier traffic carrying goods to support people's lives and materials for national development. The people will also have better access to marketplaces, education and healthcare across the river.

Government of Japan has cooperated with Timor-Leste in the areas of “establishing the foundation for the economic growth from the instauration”, “agricultural and rural development” and “capacity building of public sector and government”.

The Government of Japan strongly hopes that this project will be implemented in a timely and appropriate manner through close cooperation and coordination between both governments.
